Question: What's better than a motorcycle rideout? Answer: A motorcycle ride and a boat trip. And at DAM we go even better: A motorcycle rideout and 3 boat trips.
Yes, it's that time of year again. It's the 3 Ferries run taking in Dartmouth Higher Ferry, Torpoint Ferry and the Bodinnick Ferry.

ROUTE -139 miles

Lots of cross-water and coastal fun with this rideout. Starting at Steamer Quay in Totnes, we will make our way down to the Dartmouth Higher Ferry. After crossing the River Dart, we will head inland to bypass Slapton Sands as the road is still closed, stopping for coffee and comfort break in Kingsbridge. Re-fuelled, we depart via the A379 to retrace the original route Plymouth. Here we cross the Tamar on the Torpoint Ferry into Cornwall and on to Looe for a lunch stop.

After lunch we head for the Bodinnick ferry, into Fowey, then move inland to Lostwithiel, Dobwalls and Minions. On to Callington and Tavistock, over Dartmoor, finishing at the Dartmoor Lodge, Ashburton. The sun will shine and the waters will be calm.

Dartmouth Higher Ferry £4:00, contactless only, no cash.
Torpoint Ferry £1.00, cash or card.
Bodinnick Ferry £4.00, cash or card.
