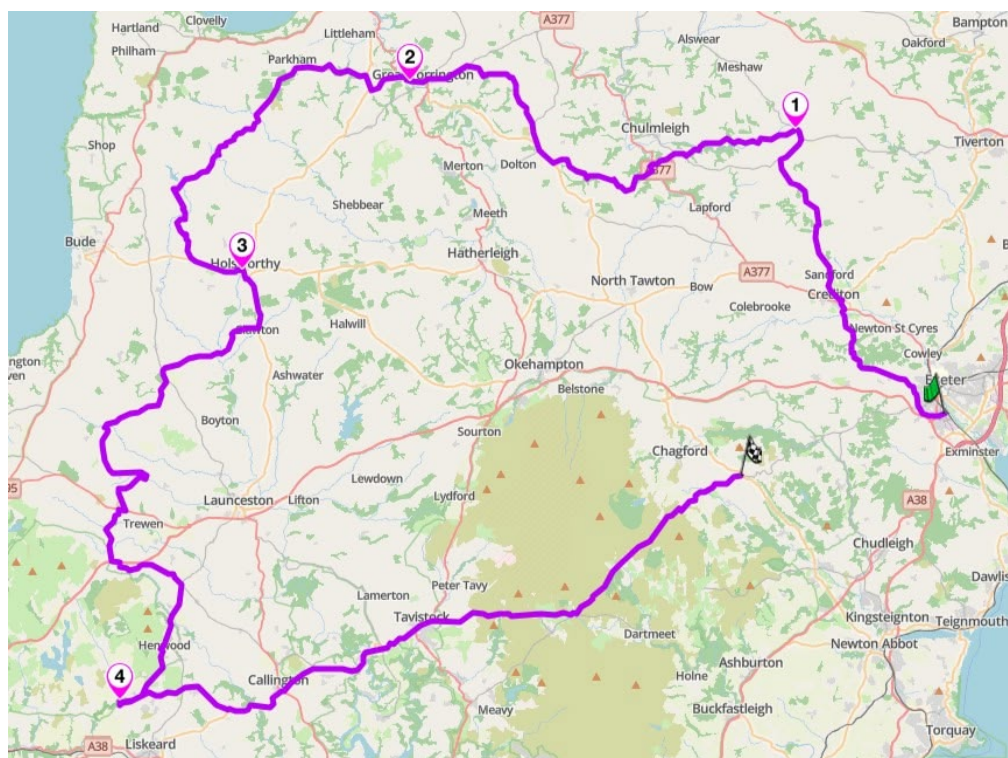
Approx 150 MILES, 5.5 HOURS RIDING

It's summer, so we should have long rides. We will start a little earlier than normal.

The route will take in classic Devon and Cornwall 'highways'. They will all be metalled, but many of them will be narrow and windy. You are welcome to find your own more direct routes between the refreshment stops if you wish. In fact, if it is wet or cold, I'll likely do the same.

09:00	Depart Exeter Via Crediton, Blackdog
10:00	Arrive Witheridge Short 'Pitstop'
10:15	Depart Witheridge Via Chawleigh, Roborough
11:15	Arrive Torrington Common 'Early Lunch' Stop
12:00	Depart Torrington Via Buckland Brewer, Bradworthy
13:00	Arrive Holsworthy Petrol Stop
13:15	Depart Holsworthy Via East Cornwall, Five lanes
14:30	Arrive Inkies Smokehouse, Golitha Falls 'Late Lunch' Stop
15:30	Depart Inkies Via Tavistock
16:45	Arrive Moretonhampstead End of ride
